SÉBASTIEN LOEB SPORT AREA

CAH - HAGUENAU

IN THE HEART OF HAGUENAU

The Sébastien Loeb sport area is a 4,000 m² building and consists of 3 modular development areas as well as a climbing wall. It allows the practice of a wide range of sporting activities.

The main hall can accommodate up to 700 spectators with bleachers on either side of the pitch.

The sports activities practiced daily by the town's sports clubs are handball, which plays in the National 3 league, basketball, with a women's team playing in the National 2 league.

3 modular halls for basketball, handball, badminton and table tennis.

The space has 10 changing rooms and is available for a weight room, a treatment room and an anti-doping room.

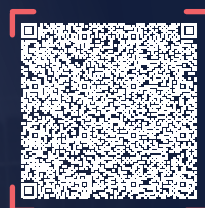

LAND OF GYMNASSTS

The Union is a hall dedicated to gymnastics. It hosts the Haguenau SGS Union, the town iconic club founded in 1886.

It is part of a sports complex directly connected to the main hall of the Espace Sébastien Loeb.

The buildings are linked by two interior passages, thus allowing for two gymnastics areas.

The SGS Union de Haguenau offers a wide range of gymnastics activities: artistic, rhythmic and trampoline.

It is the oldest sports association in the town and has produced many champions:

Mathilde Wahl (Bar and floor speciality and 5th in the team competition at the European Championships in 2018),

Morgane Osyssek (TOP 12, silver and bronze medals at the 2022 Mediterranean Games),

Sophie Darous and Aliénor Robbe Meyer (world champions in synchronised trampoline in 2022).

THE MAISON DES SPORTS

The Maison des Sports has a beautiful 1,240 m² multi-sports hall with a renovated floor in 2014, ideal for hosting basketball competitions.

In 2022, the Maison des Sports was not only modernised, but the ventilation and heating system was also redesigned to be environmentally friendly and efficient, and the changing rooms were cooled.

The hall is equipped with stands for 850 people and a 234 m² multi-activity training room.

The complex hosts national basketball competitions. The hall can be used as a weight room, table tennis room, treatment room and anti-doping room.

CAH - HAGUENAU

THE DOJO

The DOJO was inaugurated in 2022.

Its floor area is 1,225 m², on one level for easy access. It consists in:

2 judo combat areas (14x26 m),

1 aikido and karate combat area (14x14 m),

a grandstand with a capacity of 100 people which completes the combat area, and 6 changing rooms.

The main users of the new Dojo are the judo club, the karate club and the aikido club.

The Maison des Sports and the Dojo can be shared and have a direct link.

Rugby & Football SPORTS PARK



CAH - HAGUENAU

The Sports Park is made up of a set of 8 natural or synthetic turf pitches (renovated in 2022) allowing training sessions and competitions of national level.

1 football field of honour,
1 main rugby pitch,
1 annex football pitch,
2 synthetic pitches,
1 multi-sports annex,
1 baseball field,
a 6-lane track,
and athletics facilities.

A weight room is available on site. Clubhouses are available for your team meetings and can be converted into a treatment room and an anti-doping room.

The Sports Park hosts 5 resident sports clubs on a daily basis. These include the football club, which plays in the National 2 league, and the rugby club, which plays in the National 3 league.

RÉMY HUCKEL SPORT CENTRE

CAH - BRUMATH

The Rémy Huckel sports complex covers an area of **80,000 m²** and consists of **four fields**.

It was completely renovated in 2020.

The Hubert Steinmetz athletics stadium has a **8-lane 400m track** and a throwing stadium.

A 2,500-meter long soft running track, equipped with exercise equipment, surrounds the stadium and offers a path through the nearby forest.

The sports complex also features a city stadium with a soccer field and a basketball court, as well as a multi-slide area with a pump track and a skate park.

OMNISPORT CENTRE

CAH - BRUMATH

The Omnisport Centre covers an area of 3,600 m² and includes a **multi-sports area** (designed for handball, basketball, volleyball, badminton, etc.)

a **gymnastics hall** (with equipment to FIG standards)

a **weightlifting room**, a **weight training room**, a **climbing wall**.

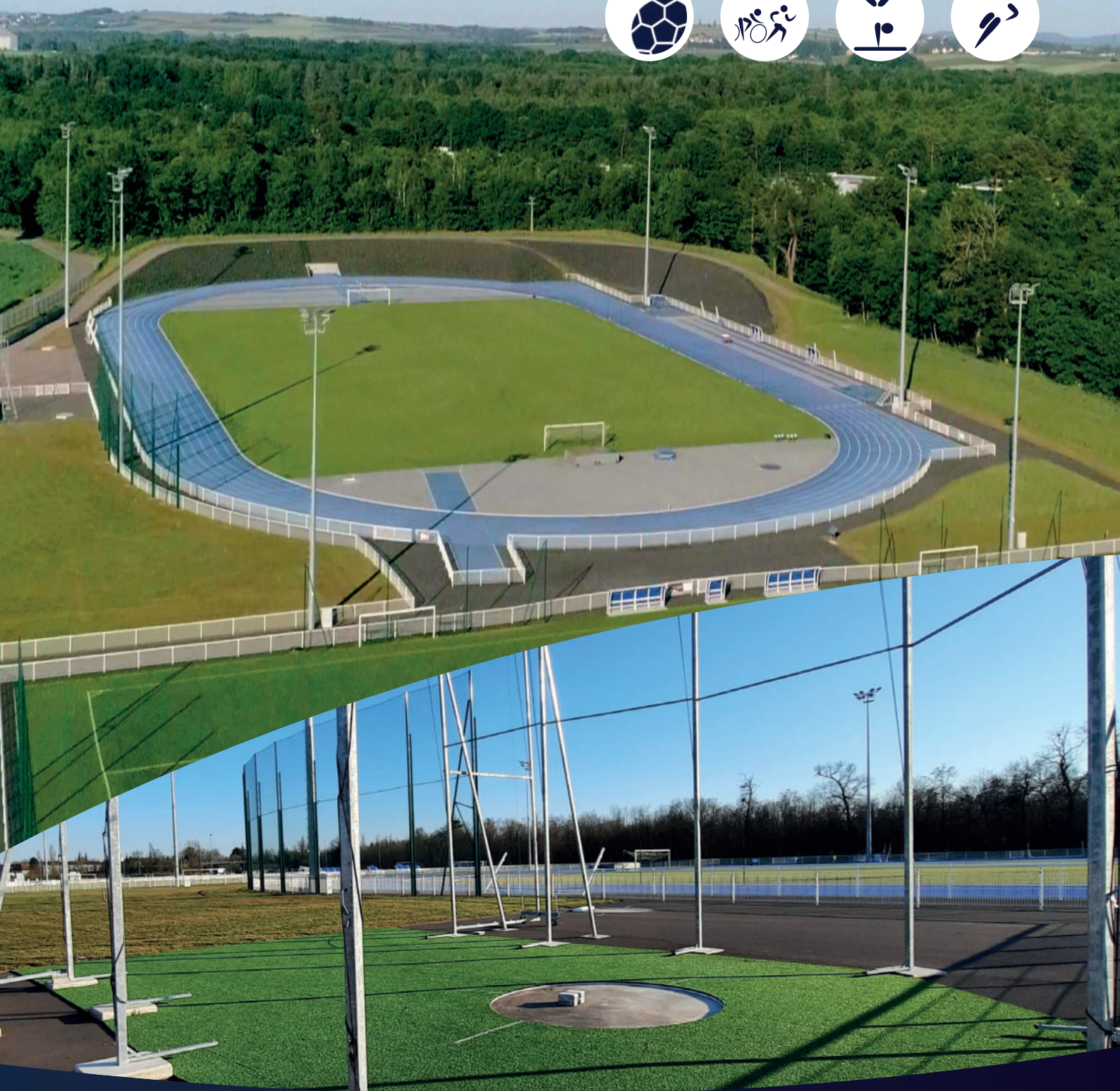

INDOOR SPORT CENTRE

The indoor sports centre consists of a reception hall, an exhibition area, a cafeteria and several activity rooms.

JOSEPH HECKEL SPORT CENTRE

Judo, handball & basketball

The new complex consists of a 180 m² reception and social area, including a 100 m² common room. **A multi-sports area of 1,480 m²** including a 1,056 m² sports hall with 5 changing rooms, an anti-doping room and a storage room. A 540 m² dojo area, including a 460 m² dojo with 3 changing rooms, an office and ancillary premises.

The total useful area is approximately 2,300 m².

3,000 m² more of outdoor facilities are available.

The multi-sports hall has a stand that can accommodate **250 people seated** (with disabled people access) and about 50 standing.

ROBERT KAEUFLING SPORT CENTRE

Ground floor: reception hall, multi-sports hall, dance hall, changing rooms, showers, toilets, infirmary, patio, kitchen, bar

1st floor: dance room, dojo, changing rooms, showers, toilets

The Robert Kaeufling Sports Centre has a total surface area of 4,631 m².

The size of the different areas is 1,155 m².

All these sports facilities are located in a quiet, natural setting for athletic preparation and performance.

The multi-sports hall:

36 standing places and 500 seats in the stands (disabled people access).

Dojo: 306 m², 100 seats in the stands (disabled people access).

Dance hall: 170 m².

Stadiums: a **synthetic pitch** and a 150-seat stand **honor field**.

Athletics track: a 6-lanes 400 m ring (track lighting), long jump and triple jump, javelin throw, shot put, high jump.

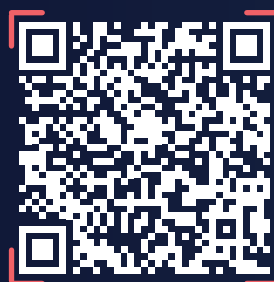
